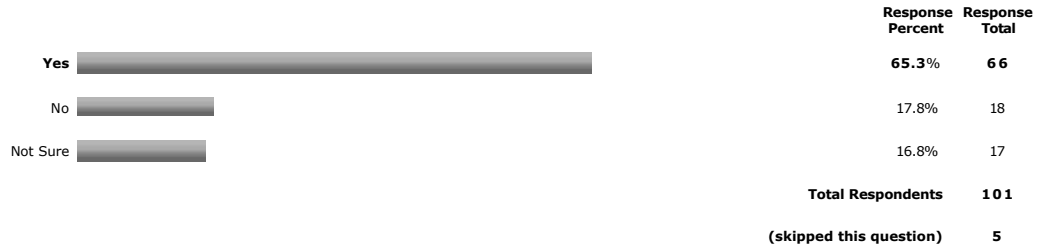

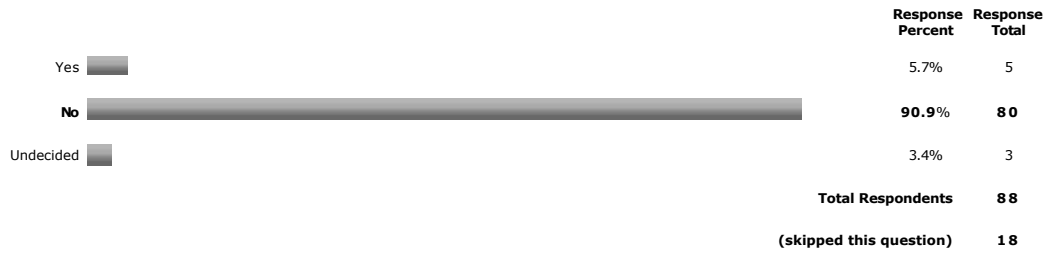

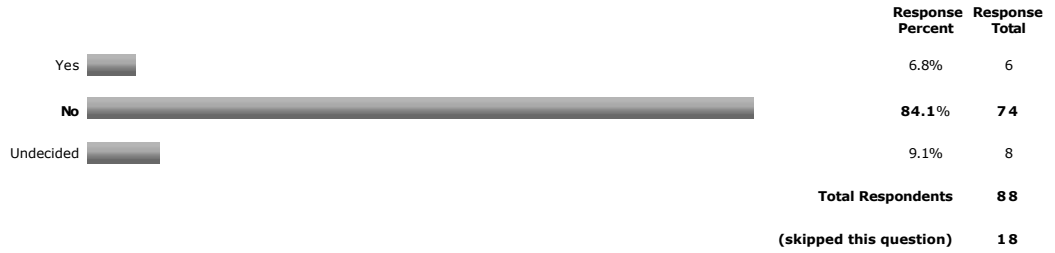

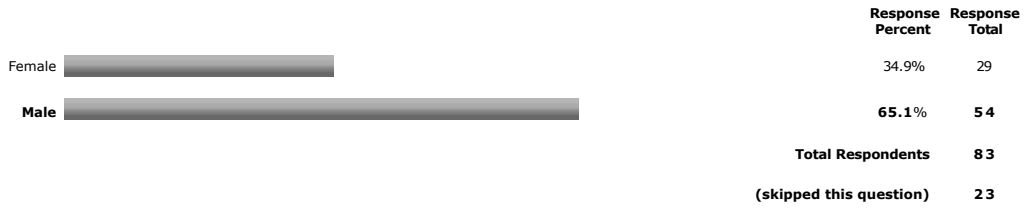


13. Death at 10 years after treatment?

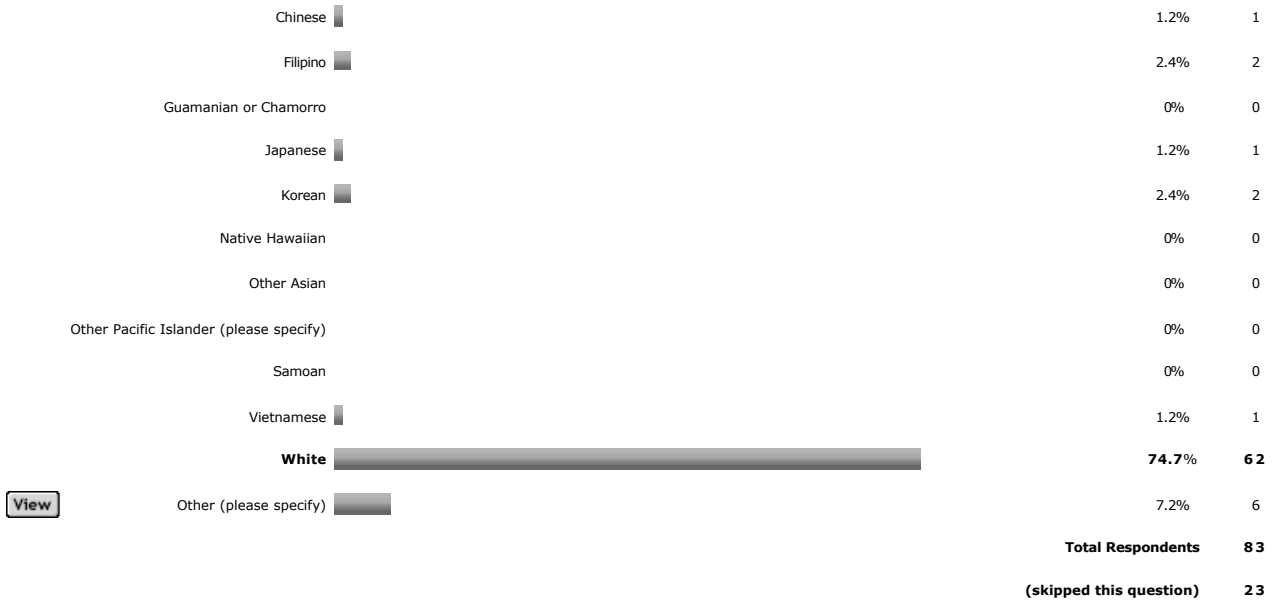

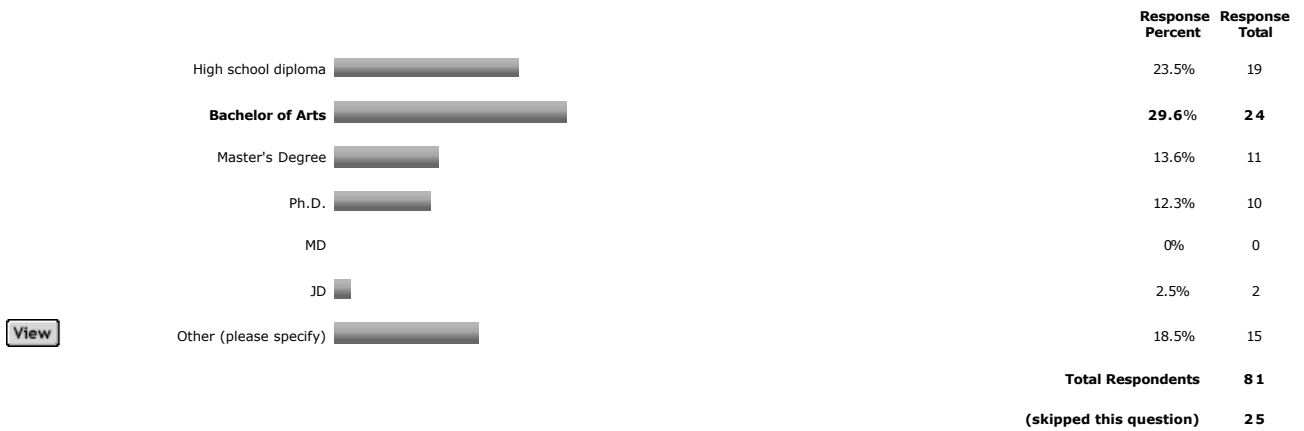




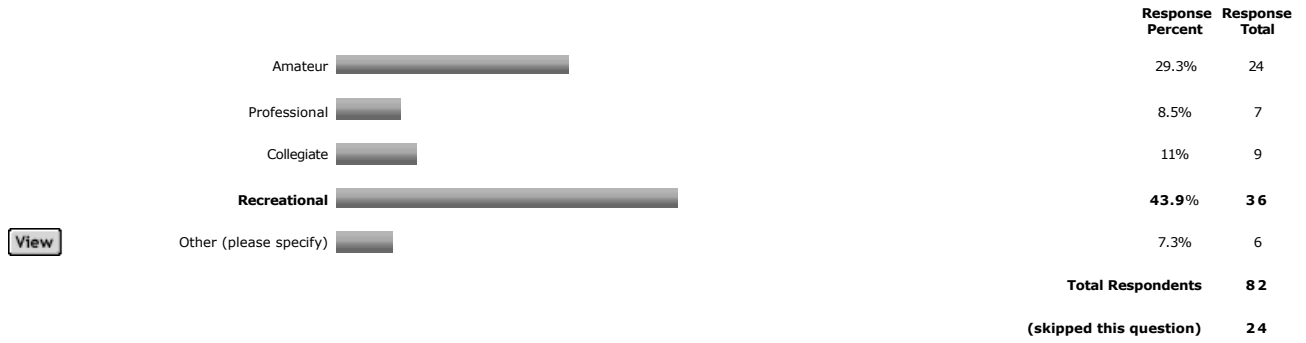

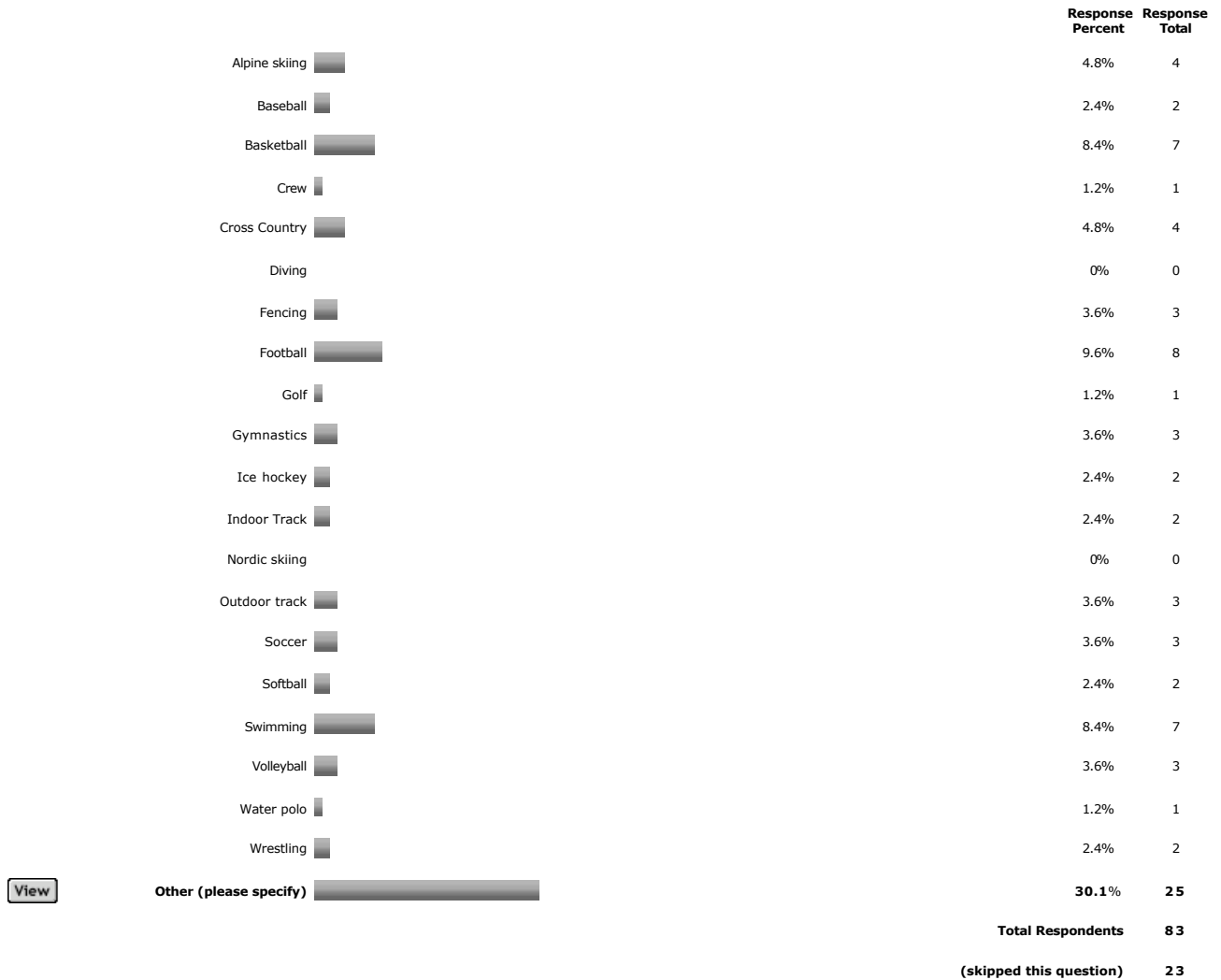
18. What is your level of education?
